It is notified for the Kashmiri Migrants that the State Government after considering the guidelines issued by All India Council for Technical Education and Ministry of Human Resources Development has reserved one seat in each Engineering/MBA/MCA/B.Pharmacy/M-Pharmacy/Hotel Management & Catering Technology, Diploma in Engineering in Thapar University, Punjabi University, Engineering Colleges and Polytechnic Colleges of the State for admission of wards of Kashmiri Migrants for the academic session 2017-2018. The counseling of the candidates shall be held on 21.07.2017 at 10.A.M. in the committee room of Directorate of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab, Plot No.1, Sector 36-A, Chandigarh. The last date of submission of complete application is 20.07.2017 upto 5.00 p.m. The other details about courses and guidelines for admission and prescribed performa are available on the Directorate's website www.dtepunjab.gov.in

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Courses:-

- (i) Diploma/Degree courses in Polytechnic/Engineering Colleges.
- (ii) Diploma/Degree Courses and Post Graduation in Pharmacy.
- (iii) Post graduate Degree course in Computer Application (MCA)
- (iv) Post graduate Degree course in Business Administration (MBA)
- (v) Admission in 2nd year Degree course in Engineering (Lateral Entry) from amongst Diploma holders.
- (vi) Diploma/Degree course in Hotel Management & Catering Technology.

A. The following are the guidelines for admission to the above mentioned courses:-

1. The condition of domicile requirement for Kashmiri Migrants is waived off.
2. One seat in each Polytechnic/Engineering College is hereby created on supernumerary basis of admission of wards of Kashmiri Migrants.

Admission shall be made only on the basis of marks obtained in JEE (Main) 2017/CMAT-2017/GPAT-2017 Examination. In respect of courses where there is no entrance test, the admission shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in qualifying examination. However for the seat of Thapar University, Patiala The Candidate sponsored must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with at least 60% (55% for

SC/ST Candidates) marks in aggregate of three subjects, namely, Physics, Mathematics and any one subject out of Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology and Technical Vocational subject OR Minimum 60% (55% for the SC/ST candidates) marks in a Diploma recognized by AICTE or a State Board of Technical Education of at least 3 year duration.

3. The fee shall be charged as per rates fixed for session 2017-18 by the State Government/University.
4. Each candidate shall have to give proof of his being a Kashmiri Migrant or a ward of Kashmiri Migrant alongwith the Application Form.

B. COUNSELLING OF CANDIDATES.

- i) Counseling of the candidates shall be held on 21.07.2017 at 10.00 A.M. in the Committee Room of Directorate of Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab, Plot No. 1, Sector 36-A, Chandigarh. Only those candidates shall be considered who have applied against these seats in time.
- ii) No separate letter for counseling shall be issued.

Subject: Guidelines for admission of Kashmiri Migrants in Polytechnic/ Engineering Colleges/University during the Session 2017-2018.

Kindly refer to the subject noted above.

2. The State Government has considered the guidelines issued by AICTE, New Delhi and Ministry of Human Resources Development, Delhi and the following guidelines are hereby laid for admission of Kashmiri Migrants in Polytechnic/ Engineering Colleges/Punjabi University of the State in the following courses:-

Courses:

- (i) Diploma/ Degree courses in Polytechnic/ Engineering Colleges.
- (ii) Diploma/ Degree courses and Post Graduation in Pharmacy.
- (iii) Post graduate Degree course in Computer Application (MCA).
- (iv) Post graduate Degree course in Business Administration (MBA).
- (v) Admission in 2nd year Degree course in Engineering (Lateral Entry) from amongst Diploma holders.
- (vi) Diploma/ Degree course in Hotel Management & Catering Technology

3. The following are the guidelines for admission to the above mentioned courses:-

- (i) The condition of domicile requirement for Kashmiri Migrants is waived off.
- (ii) One seat in each Polytechnic/Engineering College is hereby created on supernumerary basis of admission of wards of Kashmiri Migrants.

(iii) Admission shall be made only on the basis of marks obtained in JEE (Main)-2017/CMAT-2017/GPAT-2017 Examination conducted by the Central Board of School Examination, and M.S. University, Baroda. In respect of courses, where there is no entrance test, the admission shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in 10th/10+2/Diploma merit wise. However for the seat of Thapar University, Patiala "A Candidate sponsored must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with at least 60% (55% for SC/ST Candidates) marks in aggregate of three subjects, namely, Physics, Mathematics and any one subject out of Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology and Technical Vocational subject OR Minimum 60% (55% for the SC/ST candidates) marks in a Diploma recognized by AICTE or a State Board of Technical Education of at least 3 year duration".
- (iv) Application for admission shall be called by the Director, Technical Education & Industrial Training and seats would be allocated to the students at the earliest possible.
- (v) The fees shall be charged as per rates fixed for session 2017-2018 by the State Government/University.
- (vi) Each candidate shall have to give proof of his being a Kashmiri Migrant or a ward of Kashmiri Migrant along with the Application Form.
